

On Exam Day

- Be on time and only bring what you need, e.g. a **BLACK** pen, pencil, ruler, compass and calculator (if appropriate). No other equipment is allowed. Please leave valuables at home.
- Learn your exam number – you will be seated in exam number order for every exam, not alphabetically or by set. Your exam number can be found on your individual timetable.
- Look out for the seating plan outside the dining hall on exam days and locate your seat on it before you go into the exam room.
- As soon as you enter the exam room, you must stop talking and remain quiet until you have left the room.
- Every desk has a card with an exam number and name on it – find your seat quickly and quietly and sit down.
- Listen to the instructions given – if you cannot hear or do not understand, raise your hand and an invigilator will try to help you. You must not shout out.
- When the exam is finished do not get up and go – WAIT until all the exam papers have been collected and the invigilator dismisses your row. Then leave quietly. There may be others still working even though your exam has finished.
