Dear Parent/Carer,

I hope that despite the disruption caused by Coronavirus that your family were able to enjoy the recent Christmas break.

We were delighted to welcome all students back to school on Tuesday.

In order to keep our community as safe as possible in the coming weeks:

- All students should take a lateral flow test twice a week
- Anyone with coronavirus symptoms should stay at home and arrange for a PCR test to be taken
