Proposed Industrial Action- 1st February 2023

Dear Parents/ Carers,

You will be aware that the largest teaching union has planned a series of industrial action, with the first planned day on the 1st February. This means that we will need to close the school to the majority of students- other than Year 11. Those students at home will have remote learning provided and this will be a mixture of live lessons and independent tasks. We will be in contact again regarding future strike dates, or if the situation changes. The following arrangements will be in place on the 1st February:

Years 7-10

Students must stay at home unless individually invited into school by Mr O'Sullivan.

- For each subject, there will be work available on-line through Google Classrooms.
- Students should check their lessons for the day at 8.30am.
- Live, Google Classroom lessons will take place for some lessons- these will occur at the time indicated on a students' timetable (available through Talaxy). These lessons will be accessed by clicking a Google Classroom assignment in that lesson's classroom called "Feb 1st Live Lesson- Period X, TIME XXX". This assignment will be available by 8.30am so students will know what to expect during the day.
- For other lessons, specific or existing work (revision/existing homework etc) will be available, again through Google Classroom.

Year 11

Year 11 students are required in school between 9am and 2.00pm. In this time students will have various sessions, including those on study skills and preparation for examinations.

Q6

Arrangements will be as above for Years 7-10, however a supervised work/study space (Q1) will be available for Q6 students between 8.30am and 3.20pm, should they wish to use it.
