

GCE, GCSE or GCSE Equivalent Certificates

Awarding bodies send certificates for successful candidates to schools in November/December following the examination. You will be contacted to come into the school to collect them.

As soon as you receive your certificates, please check that all the personal details printed on them, such as your name and date of birth are correct. Please notify the Exams Officer at once if there are any mistakes.

You are advised to keep your certificates in a safe place. Keep them flat in a protective cover. They will be required as evidence of your achievement should you decide to go to college, university or apply for a job. Never send originals of your certificates to universities, colleges or employers. It is good practice to take copies and send those if required.

If you do lose your certificate, be advised that awarding bodies do issue replacement certificates at a cost. We can provide a 'Statement of Results', which colleges and universities will accept as evidence of achievement, however, this is not as impressive as a certificate.
