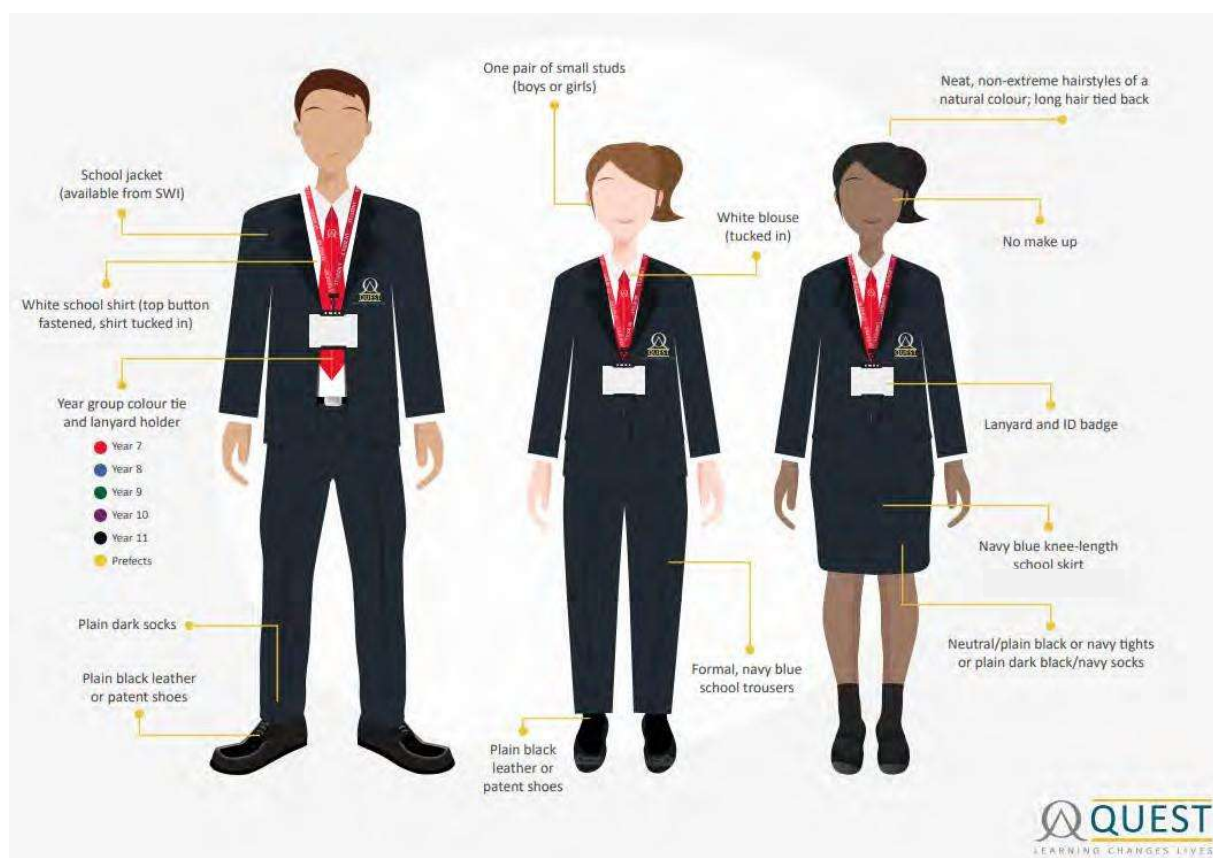


**All students are expected to wear their uniform with pride,
both in school and in the local community**



The Uniform

Items marked with an * below **MUST** be purchased from our school uniform supplier (SWI)

Blazer*	Navy blue with the Quest logo The blazer must always be worn inside the Academy buildings
Skirt or Trousers	Knee-length navy blue school skirt. This must be a professional, formal skirt, either plain or pleated Formal, navy blue school trousers



Tie*	Clip-on tie in the appropriate year group colour
Jumper* (optional)	Navy blue V-neck jumper with the Quest logo No other jumpers are allowed Hooded tops and denim jackets are not allowed under or over other garments
Shirt Or Blouse	Plain, white, short or long-sleeved in a classic style Vests or undergarments must be white and not visible under the shirt
Shoes	Plain black leather or patent school shoes, capable of being polished. The following are not allowed: • Suede or fabric shoes • Open-toed, backless or sling-back shoes • Boots • High-heeled shoes • Trainers (except those that are black and can be polished) • Heels • Pumps • Canvas, patterned shoes • Excessive decorative features • Large sport logos visible on the outside of the shoe
Tights or Socks	Plain black or navy tights, with no patterns Plain black/navy/dark grey or white socks
ID Card / Lanyard	ID card and student lanyard in year group colour to be worn at all times
Belt	Plain black or navy blue only Large buckles displaying logos are not permitted
Hijab	Plain black or plain navy blue only
School bag and pencil case	A school bag suitable to carry textbooks, exercise books and stationery. No pouches allowed. The pencil case must contain: pen, pencil, ruler, rubber, calculator
Outdoor coat, hat, scarf and gloves (optional)	Coats must not have large or excessive logos and any decoration must be appropriate for school (i.e. no offensive language or imagery) Hats are <u>not to be worn</u> inside the building, except when going to the tutor room at the start of the day and leaving at the end of the day. Please see below for more information on coats.



Coats Around the Academy Building

Around the Academy site, students are expected to wear their blazers at all times, at all times of day, both inside and outside the building. During colder months, students are able to carry their coats around the site, however, they should only be **worn** at the following times:

- On arrival to school and then as they move inside to Tutor time
- Moving to, during and travelling to lessons after break
- Moving to, during and travelling to lessons after lunch
- At the end of the day when going home

Coats should **never be worn** in lessons.

Items of clothing which must be purchased from SWI, and display the school logo, are:

1. Blazer
2. PE top
3. Tie (can also be purchased via the school)
4. Replacements for lost lanyards and ID cards must be purchased through the school

APPEARANCE

Make Up, Nails, Hooded Tops and Jewellery

- Make-up, eye lash extensions or false eye lashes, fake tan, nail varnish or nail extensions of any kind may not be worn
- Spray deodorant, body sprays, or perfumes cannot be brought into the school and will be confiscated
- Hooded tops of a sweatshirt material may **not** be brought to school
- An ordinary analogue/digital watch may be worn
- No smart watches are allowed
- One or a pair of small studs may be worn in the lower lobe of each ear. No other visible jewellery, including body piercings or tongue studs, are allowed



Hair

- Long hair must be tied back
- Hairbands must be plain dark blue or black
- Haircuts must be no shorter than *a number two*
- Straight line functional braiding is allowed

Hair must be worn in a simple style and hair extensions must be of a sensible length and in a natural colouring – i.e. no red, green, blue extensions etc.

The following are **not** allowed:

- Decorative hair accessories
- Durags, head wraps or bandanas
- No unnaturally coloured streaks or hair colourings
- Unconventional/elaborate styles or extensive braiding, including: beading, patterned braiding, mohicans, tram lines (in hair or eyebrows), indents or shaved patterns

An unnaturally striking appearance is inappropriate. If in doubt over whether a planned style would be acceptable, parents/students should contact the Academy and seek advice before having the hair styled.

PE Kit

Items marked with an * below **MUST** be purchased from our school uniform supplier (SWI). Students are expected to bring and wear PE kit to all practical Physical Education lessons, including enrichment lessons, training sessions and practical BTEC Sport lessons.

They may wear either:

- The Quest Academy navy/white PE polo shirt* **OR** The Quest Academy navy/white multi-sports top*
- Plain black / navy tracksuit bottoms or shorts
- Navy/white socks or plain white socks
- Trainers must be sturdy and suitable for sport with non-marking soles (moulded boots or blades are acceptable for the astro-turf pitches, but not indoors)

PLEASE WRITE THE STUDENT'S NAME AND TUTOR GROUP ON ALL ITEMS OF KIT SO THAT IF LOST AND FOUND THEY CAN BE RETURNED.

Jewellery may not be worn in PE lessons for safety reasons.
